1. Oakwood opened in **1987** so it's 20 this year.
2. It's the fastest ride in the park, **Speed**, and it opened in 2006.
3. It's the Treetops coaster which will get smaller children in training for Megafobia!
4. It's **Matt the Magic Man** and you can catch his magic shows, Punch and Judy show and circus skills workshop in the Magic Factory Theatre. Check your park map on arrival for times. Please note: Matt does not perform on Mondays & Tuesdays.
5. **Cardiff** has been a city for 100 years and Wales' capital for 50 years.
6. Oakwood's in **Pembrokeshire** which is famous for its beautiful beaches and breathtaking coastal paths.
7. It's **Cyril the Squirrel!** Hopefully you've heard some of Cyril's jokes on Oakwood's website, why not pop back to [www.oakwoodthemepark.co.uk](http://www.oakwoodthemepark.co.uk) and send him one of yours? You can win a prize for every joke that's used!
8. It's **After Dark** and this spectacular event is running for the whole of August 2007.
